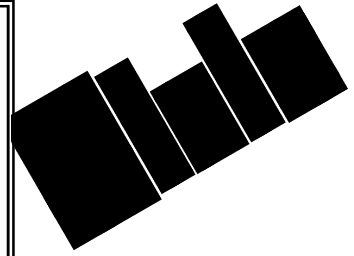

## REGULAR ATTIRE FOR STUDENTS ALL SHIRTS MUST BE TUCKED IN AT ALL TIMES

### GIRLS

Tops – Polo's may be worn in the following colors: white and navy ONLY. When notified during colder weather, students may wear white or navy long sleeve crew neck or turtleneck shirts under polo shirts.

Skirts/Jumpers – Skirts or jumpers may be worn in solid navy or khaki ONLY. Skirt/Jumper length is two inches (2") above knee (front and back).

Pants/Shorts – (Dockers Style) Navy twill or Khaki colors may be worn in either item. Shorts (walking style) may be worn the first two months and the last two months of school. **NO TIGHT OR BAGGY** styles. Pants/slacks are to be worn properly at waist. **Belts required in the following colors: brown, black, or navy ONLY.**

Outerwear – (to be worn outside classroom only) PROFESSIONAL TEAM JACKETS may NOT be worn. CCS blue jackets and collegiate jackets are preferred. Sweatshirts – **solid white, navy, or CCS sweatshirts**. Sweatshirts without hoods may be worn over polo shirts in classroom. Hooded sweatshirts will be considered outerwear. NO brand logo or trade names. No exceptions.

Shoes/Socks – Dress casual or tennis shoes. No opened toed sandals or thick heeled shoes. Socks and tights may be worn in white, navy, or black colors. Socks/Hosiery must be worn with all shoes.

Jewelry/Tattoos – NO body piercing and NO tattoos may be worn. A two (2) earring maximum may be worn in the lobe of the ear. Earrings must not be larger than a quarter. One small chain may be worn around the neck. No colorful necklaces or scarves.

Grooming – Hair must be neat and conservative in style. Modest make-up may be worn. No color hair sprays, glitter, etc.

**Chapel Attire** – Every Wednesday a navy skirt or jumper (no skort), must be worn with a white dress blouse. No polo shirt may be worn on chapel day.

Free Dress – Jeans (not tight, baggy, or oversized) or slacks with God-pleasing shirts (no logos, slogans, inappropriate designs, sleeveless shirts, tank tops, or anything that the administration deems inappropriate).

Please note: Skulls, inappropriate logos and/or designs, etc. on any attire including shoes, hats, jackets, sweatshirts, backpacks, etc. are not allowed.

**BOYS/GIRLS** – Dennis Uniform NAVY Blazers and/or V-neck sweaters may be worn for chapel (absolutely no other color or logo may be worn).

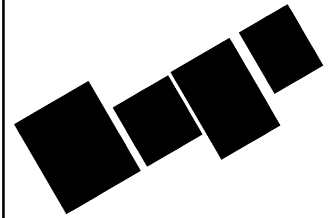

### BOYS

Shirts – Polo's, sweatshirts and turtlenecks may be worn in the following colors: white and navy ONLY. When notified during colder weather, students may wear white or navy long sleeve crew neck or turtleneck shirts under polo shirts.

Pants/Shorts – (Dockers Style) Navy twill or Khaki colors may be worn. Uniform navy twill or khaki shorts (walking style) may be worn the first two months and the last two months of school. **NO BAGGY** styles. Pants/slacks are to be worn properly at waist. **Belts required** in the following colors: brown, black, or navy ONLY.

Outerwear – (to be worn outside classroom only) **PROFESSIONAL TEAM JACKETS** may NOT be worn. CCS blue jackets and collegiate jackets are preferred. Sweatshirts – **solid** white, navy, or CCS sweatshirts. Sweatshirts without hoods may be worn over polo shirts in classroom. Hooded sweatshirts will be considered outerwear. **NO** brand logo or trade names. No exceptions.

Shoes/Socks – Dress casual or tennis shoes. **NO** opened-toed sandals, socks must be worn.

Hats/Gloves – solid colored beanies may be worn outdoors for warmth only in cold weather. **NO BASEBALL CAPS** at anytime.

Jewelry/Tattoos – **NO EARRINGS** (cannot be covered with a band-aid) or body piercing. No tattoos (or any marking/drawing on the skin).

Grooming – Hair must be neat and conservative in style, above the collar length in the back. Bangs must be neatly trimmed above eyebrows. No tails or ponytails may be worn. No braids, twists, or dread locks. No large afros. No color hair sprays glitter, etc.

**Chapel Attire** – Every Wednesday khaki or Navy color pants (no shorts) with oxford white dress shirt and tie must be worn (no collarless shirts). No polo shirt may be worn on chapel day. Short or long sleeve dress shirt is acceptable.

Free Dress – Jeans (not baggy or oversized) or slacks with God-pleasing shirts (no logos, slogans, inappropriate designs, sleeveless shirts, or anything that the administration deems inappropriate). Please note: Skulls, inappropriate logos and/or designs, etc. on any attire including shoes, hats, jackets, sweatshirts, backpacks, etc. are not allowed.

**BOYS/GIRLS** – Dennis Uniform NAVY Blazers and/or V-neck sweaters may be worn for chapel (absolutely no other color or logo may be worn).
